St Luke's Seeks a New Music Director

St. Luke's Episcopal Church is a small parish in Los Gatos with a high church tradition. We are searching for a part-time music director to lead and support our worship.

Music plays a central role in the spiritual life of our parish. We value how traditional hymns and service music ground and enhance our worship. Since the pandemic we have had no choir, but our hope is that a new director will nurture and reestablish a volunteer choir. Currently we have five cantors who lead hymns and occasionally sing anthems.

The duties of our music director include:

- Playing the organ for a Saturday 5:00 p.m. service and a Sunday 10:00 a.m. service, and extra services on certain pre-determined holy days
- Choosing hymns in collaboration with the rector
- Selecting and playing a prelude and postlude for each service
- Administering copyright licensing
- Scheduling cantors
- Arranging music scores when necessary
- Organizing a choir and holding choir practices
- Selecting anthems
- Scheduling required organ and piano tuning and maintenance
- Developing other activities to enhance the musical life of the church

Salary is by negotiation. It is anticipated that the duties will require 15-20 hours per week, depending on the liturgical season. Playing for weddings and funerals is remunerated separately.

St. Luke's celebrates diversity, respects the dignity of every human being, and is an equal opportunity employer. All qualified applicants are encouraged to apply.
